PED ARTs & CRAFTs

How to make your own Tongue depressor puppet made from stuff found around the ED.

- 1. <u>Collect Supplies:</u> Trauma Shears Assorted Googly Eyes Tongue Depressors Wooden q-tips Sharpie (various colors) White board markers work too. Pipe Cleaners White Glue or Hot Glue or Derma-bond (note this is prohibitively expensive, not recommended) Paper clips (glasses) Kelly Clamps/Iris scissors Colorful Co-Band
- 2. Cut the depressors as shown
- 3. Color in the mouth (B)
- 4. Glue head (C) to Mouth (B)
- 5. Lay body (A) on top of Mouth (B)
- 6. Glue a wrapper/paper around the two sticks together (note only glue to the front of the body)
- 7. Try out the sliding mechanism
- 8. Add eyes and nose (use scraps of depressors for nose and eyebrows, or just use a pen)
- 9. Add details!
- 10. Try to make yourself... or co workers!
